

Enrollment / Registration

- New Students must register at time of enrollment and pay annual registration fee of \$50
- Returning Students must register before the start of the school year on September 3rd and pay annual registration fee of \$40
- Ensure enrollment forms including email, phone, emergency contact information are legible and fully completed
- Registration forms available in the studio and on the website

*Tuition Policies

- Tuition is based on a 4-week session in a 48-week School year, beginning in September.
- Tuition due prior to start of each published session and if paid later than 10 days into the session will be assessed a \$20 late Fee.
- OR Tuition may be paid monthly on 1st of each month throughout the year for 12 months, including summer months. Tuition paid later than the 10th of the month will be assessed \$20 late fee.
- Please make sure to write student's name on check.
- · Checks payable to Santa Clara Ballet School.
- If you wish to set up payment with your bank's Bill Pay, you may mail checks to Santa Clara Ballet School, 3123 Millar Avenue, Santa Clara and please ensure to include student's name in the check.
- Bounced checks assessed \$30 fee
- No refunds or adjustments are allowed. Exceptions will be made for special circumstances.

Vacation and Absences:

- Students taking extended vacations, may pay per session according to the schedule or if taking partial sessions, must pay the full session fee.
- Students / Parents should provide written notification of their absence by emailing the school or providing written notice in the studio.

• Make-up classes: Missed classes may be made up by the first week of the following month. Missed classes cannot be deducted from the regular monthly tuition.
